Autism ALERT staff will work with your practice to set up a training. You'll learn more about autism screening and how to refer families to Autism ALERT.

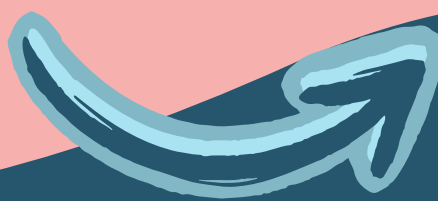


Start Referring!
