

Community Capacity Building Funding – Technical Assistance (TA)

Health Share of Oregon and CSH are partnering to offer technical assistance for community-based organizations (CBOs) interested in building their capacity to deliver the new Health Related Social Needs (HRSN) benefits to Oregon Health Plan (OHP, or Medicaid) members.

This TA is for CBOs serving Multnomah, Clackamas, and Washington Counties.

Who Should Participate?

CBOs who want to prepare their organization to become a HRSN service provider and who are considering applying for Community Capacity Building Funding.

Participation does not guarantee or require a CBO to become a HRSN service provider.

What does this collaboration include?

Individual TA Sessions

Organizations can contact CSH to discuss a variety of topics related to building their capacity to become a provider. Topic areas can be chosen by the organization, based on their individual needs. Common topic areas:

- **Common policies and procedures** needed for delivering HRSN services
- **Service Budget Tool** for estimating costs, predicting cash flow, and braiding funding
- **Financial Administration** for invoicing procedures and service tracking
- **Compliance and Service Oversight planning**
- **Closed Loop Referrals** and use of community information exchange (CIE) platforms
- **HRSN documentation best practices**
- **Data Security Practices**
- Best practices in **trauma informed** housing and nutrition services
- Knowing, understanding and tracking **workflow adjustments**

TA sessions also will include sample tools that can be used by CBOs to support HRSN service planning and creation of a fiscally sustainable program.
